

An Overview

Salvita is a therapeutic, residential halfway house that serves the needs of women who are recovering from substance dependency and co-occurring mental health issues. Salvita provides case management and counseling for women in a daily structured environment. Our program focus is to assist women in learning the recovery skills needed to live a stable life. The length of stay may vary depending on individual factors. While the maximum length of stay may be up to 18 months, the average length of stay is between three (3) and four (4) months.

The philosophy of the Salvita program incorporates the steps of recovery originally developed by Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) and Narcotics Anonymous (NA). Attendance at AA/NA meetings is a major requirement of the recovery program. Residents are required to seek the continuing support of the AA/NA community by securing a sponsor to assist and support them in their recovery.

Admissions

Admission is voluntary for adult women who are age eighteen (18) and older with a primary diagnosis of chemical dependency and co-occurring mental health issues who have previously completed a residential treatment program for chemical dependency. Clients must be employed at least part-time or receiving some form of monthly income. Clients who are court ordered to the program must be willing to fully participate in all aspects of the program.

Services

Salvita is a therapeutic community that provides clinical assessment, treatment planning, case management, individual counseling, group therapy, life skills classes, discharge planning and relapse prevention. Support services include vocational assessment and training and referral to Adult Education/GED classes. Transportation available as needed. Medical and nursing services are available 24 hours a day. Family participation is encouraged and provided through weekly visitation, Family Group, and a system of passes for home visits.

Continuing Care

Residential treatment provides the “tools” necessary to maintain recovery after discharge. The “Continuing Care” phase of treatment helps clients make the transition back to living in the community and learning to use the “tools” in day to day living. This phase includes weekly group counseling, random urinalysis, case management, attendance at support group meetings and referrals for outpatient counseling, if needed.

Fees for Service

DISC Village, Inc. is a private, non-profit agency. Fees are based on a sliding scale. Assistance is available for filing insurance claims. Clients are responsible for the following basic fees:

Housing (monthly fee)	\$100.00
Van Transportation (monthly fee)	\$40.00
Urinalysis Tests	\$20.00/\$10.00/\$6.00 (as needed)
Nurse Assessment (upon admission)	\$20.00
Food Stamps	are collected monthly.

Clients are responsible for all medical expenses including emergency room visits, hospitalizations, prescriptions, and dental care.

Licensure

Salvita is fully licensed by the State of Florida and is accredited through CARF.

Confidentiality

It is imperative that confidentiality be observed for the therapeutic process to occur. Strict adherence to all Federal as well as Florida Statutes is maintained.
